

GENERAL BOOTH INFORMATION
MAY 1, 2010

THE CORONA CINCO DE MAYO BOARD WILL REVIEW ALL APPLICATIONS AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO APPROVE OR DENY AN APPLICATION.

Prior to April 25, 2010

1. Vendors - Your booth location will be reserved once I receive your application with full payment prior to April 26th. A copy of the booth layout will be available for you at the meeting.
2. Misc. vendors **are not required** but are invited to attend the April 25th meeting.

Must Provide

- 1. Non-profit organizations must provide a non-profit status number**
2. Business food vendors must provide a Corona Business License and a copy of your Riverside County Health Dept. Permit

Saturday, May 1, 2010

1. You may start setting up your booth by 6:00 a.m.
2. Please check in with Johnnie Huerta as soon as you arrive at your booth site.
3. There must be an adult (18) years or older present at your booth at all times.
4. All booths should be ready and in operation by 10:00 a.m.
5. Please keep your area clean at all times.
6. Bring your own large trash bags. Additional trash bins will be available.
7. No dry palms are allowed.
8. You may need to provide your own generator for electricity, and refrigeration equipment.
9. Bring your own electrical extensions cords.
10. Please provide your own tables and chairs. **(we do not have extra tables & chairs)**
11. You are responsible to tear down your own booth and clean your area no later than 7:00 p.m.
12. All booths must follow the Corona Fire Dept. requirements. Please keep a fire extinguisher in your booth area at all times.

Per Riverside Health Department:

Due to Health Department restrictions, applications for food booths by individual WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. **ONLY BUSINESSES OR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.**

Per Corona Fire Department & Corona Police Dept:

Your booth is subject to inspection by the Corona Fire and Police Department. If you do not meet with their requirements you will be shut down. For safety reasons, please do not add additional outlets to your site. (Caution: Circuits do overload. If necessary any additional electrical outlets causing problems will be removed).

FOOD BOOTH VENDORS MEETING (ONLY FOOD VENDORS NEED TO ATTEND)

REMINDER: A mandatory meeting is scheduled to go over issues required by the Riverside County Health Department on Sunday April 25, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at the Corona City Park by Fiesta Bandshell Stage. Applications will be available for late applications. Please bring Cash or Money Order. Please No Checks.

BOOTH COMMITTEE WILL:

1. Purchase a one day food service permit for non-profit organizations.
2. Reserve a 10x10 site for you once your booth fee is paid in full.
3. *A 10x10 canopy is available and will be set up for you for an additional charge of \$25.00*
4. The Committee will contact the Parks Division to have electrical outlets available, limited usage available.
5. The Committee will work with you in order to make this event an enjoyable and safe for you and all concerned.
