GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

1. Registration table located at fifth and Merrill street, opens at 7:30 am and closes at 9:30 am
2. Parade will start promptly at 10:00 a.m.
3. Adults please be responsible of all children riding or walking along parade route.
4. **Parade entry number** - You will receive your entry number and directions to your staging locations at registration
5. Please follow the directions of the volunteers.
6. Place your entry number on the right hand side of your lead vehicle or entry.
7. Parade applications will be reviewed and categorized by the Parade Chairman.
8. Please provide your own signage or identification banner.
9. **You are not allowed to "throw" candy or anything along the parade route.** Police Dept. will pull violators off parade line up.
10. No "Silly String" is allowed along the parade route.
11. Decorations: must be non-combustible or flame retardant.
12. Motorized parade floats and towing apparatus shall provide a minimum 2-A, 10-BC rated portable fire extinguisher readily available to the driver.
13. **All vehicle entries must carry proof of vehicle insurance.**
14. **Car Clubs limit** – a maximum of six (6) vehicles per club, note; **no wheelie's allowed**
15. There will be five (5) announcers along the parade route to introduce your entry. First location at the start of the parade between Merrill and Sheridan. Second location at the Corona Mall, third location Mejia TV, fourth location the Corona Chamber office, and 5th location at the end of parade by City Park. Please pause shortly as each announcer introduces your entry.
16. Judging will be at third announcer location, at Mejia TV. 510 E. Sixth Street.
17. Time Warner Cable Television will televise the parade at 4th announcer location, at Corona Chamber office.
18. Parade will end approximately 11:30 a.m.
19. **Need a ride back to the staging area?** Starting at 12Noon until 5:00 p.m., the Corona Cruiser will transport those participating in the parade back to the staging area or City Hall parking lot. Drop off and pick up by Corona Cruiser on Quarry St. @ City Park parking lot near Fiesta Band Shell. FREE – (NO CHARGE)
